Homestay Requirements:

- Commit to the full 10 months <u>or</u> commit to split the time with another family!
- Provide a safe and nurturing family environment.
- Willing to actively support and encourage the students to practice their Catholic faith.
- Strong desire to include the pequeño/a as **a member of the family**.
- Near a bus route to Seattle Central (transfers are fine).
- Provide a bedroom with reasonable access to a bathroom (can be shared).
- Provide occasional transportation to events and meetings (when they are at night or off a bus route).
- Provide all meals (this does not mean cooking for them just being sure there is food available for all meals).
- Desire to attend occasional events/community meals with the pequeño/a, participate in the program as appropriate, and support our activities.
- Willing to help with English homework as needed.
- Able to be **flexible**!!!

Preferred:

- Christian families who are active in their faith/parish.
- Have visited or volunteered at an NPH home, or been significantly involved with NPH in the Northwest, or *desire* to become involved.
- Children still at home, adult children who visit often/live nearby, or strong support from friends/family/community.
