You will meet the amazing children (pequeños), staff, and volunteers of NPH and learn about their daily lives. Whether you are new to NPH, or have been supporting your region for many years, visiting our homes is the best way to see what we do in action.

You will have the unique opportunity to stay at the NPH home and immerse yourselves in the daily life with the pequeños. While the pequeños are in school, you will help out around the home (helping with daily chores around the property, working in the gardens and farm, caring for the babies, working in the kitchen, and viewing the school, etc.). Relax or hang out with the pequeños in the afternoons. We will coordinate activities with the different age groups throughout the week. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to meet with the leadership of the NPH home, tour all of the home's facilities, and hear testimonials from some of the children.

Cost: \$300 per person*

About NPH Guatemala

Opened in 1996, NPH Guatemala is home to approx. 335 children. The home, Casa San Andres, is located 90 minutes west of Guatemala City, the nation's capital. It is situated 5,800 feet above sea level in Guatemala's beautiful central highlands, very close to the famous colonial capital of Antigua Guatemala. Casa San Andres has approximately 25 acres of land with a Montessori preschool/ kindergarten, primary and middle schools, vocational workshops, clinic, athletic fields, a farm and greenhouses.
