Whether you are new to NPH, or a longtime supporter, visiting our homes is the best way to see what we do in action.

We will have the unique opportunity to stay at the NPH home with the children. This will allow us to immerse ourselves in NPH life with the children. While the children are in school, you will help out around the home (helping with daily chores around the property, working in the gardens and farm, caring for the babies, working in the kitchen, and viewing the school, etc.). Relax or hang out with the pequeños in the afternoons. We will coordinate activities with the different age groups throughout the week. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to meet with the leadership of the NPH home, tour all of the home's facilities, and hear "talks" from some of the children.

Casa San Salvador, the main home, is 77 miles south of Mexico City in Miaquatlan. With over 400 children, it is always bustling with activity. The 130-acre campus has a village-feel with cobblestone streets and a lush landscape. It includes a pre-school through secondary school, a chapel, dining hall, clinic, and a farm with chickens, sheep, pigs as well as fruit and vegetable gardens. Casa Buen Señor in Cuernavaca is home to more than 100 older children who attend NPH's vocational high school.
