HIGHLIGHTS

- **Bolivia:** 10 out of 12 of our children's houses started their own garden project and grew a variety of vegetables
- **Dominican Republic:** Assisted 15 families that have individuals with special needs by providing financial support and physical therapy
- **El Salvador:** Celebrated 20 years of helping children and youth
- **Guatemala:** Opened a daycare center for single mothers and shifted from disaster relief to the cultivation of community relationships at the organizational level
- **Haiti:** School at the main home (St. Helene) expanded to offer grade 11; two youth earned medals at the Special Olympics in Abu Dhabi, UAE
- **Honduras:** Began construction of the San José Family Center to serve the neighboring communities of Mata de Plátano and Pueblo Nuevo
- **Mexico:** Built their own water purification system, which has resulted in a 79% decrease in expenditures
- **Nicaragua:** 160 children and adolescents from local towns and villages joined in workshops and activities despite the nation's political unrest
- **Peru:** Implemented a family strengthening program, called "Parenting with Love and Limits" and held 31 workshops
