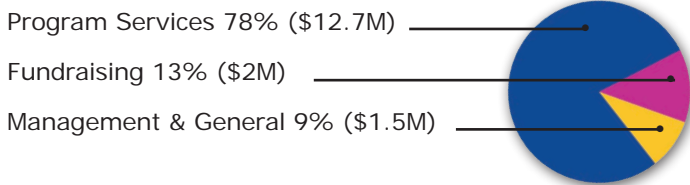
FINANCIAL INFORMATION

NPH USA is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, Federal Tax ID# 65-1229309. Donations are tax deductible to the extent provided by law and are diligently appropriated. An audited financial statement is available upon request.

What percentage of money raised by NPH USA goes to NPH?

We strive to be great stewards of our donors' financial contributions and to keep general and administrative expenses as low as possible. In 2020, 78% of our resources were spent on programs, and 22% on administration and fundraising. This includes money, medicine and in-kind gifts that were provided to NPH directly as well as expenses for activities which are of direct benefit to NPH and the children (child sponsorship, volunteer program, in-kind giving program, etc.). This percentage compares well to other non-profit organizations and is subject to an external audit every year.

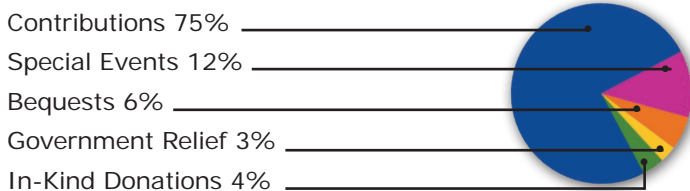
2020 Functional Expenses: \$16,323,416
