

OUR IMPACT: 2021 AT A GLANCE

Highlights

- Bolivia: Workshops prepared youth from both the home and community for independent living
- **Dominican Republic:** Launched a program to support people who have a disability or severe health condition
- El Salvador: The agriculture program started to yield corn, bananas, cashews, and more
- **Guatemala:** celebrated the graduations of nearly 100 pequeños (K-12) from both the home and the community
- Haiti: Kay St. Germaine rehabilitation center provided education and therapies to nearly 400 children with neurological disabilities from vulnerable families
- **Honduras:** Made vital improvements to meet the needs of the physically impaired, including remodeling 5 homes and expanding therapy services
- **Mexico:** Offered a youth educational program that provided resources on independent living, job skills/ job seeking, and public transport
- Nicaragua: Provided 1,747 therapeutic sessions for children with disabilities in the community
- Peru: Enhanced the daily menu at the home by incorporating more legumes and fruits, and installed magnetic water softener system to improve water quality
