### About NPH El Salvador

Opened in June 1999, NPH El Salvador is home to nearly 100 children. Casa Sagrada Familia (Holy Family), located in Textistepeque near the border with Guatemala, was constructed in 2004. The NPH El Salvador grounds include a school, chapel, peace garden, dining room and kitchen, clinic, and houses for boys and girls, among other facilities.

### Payment and Paperwork Schedule

Includes:

- Pre-trip orientation
- Hotel accommodations
- Meals at NPH and group meals
- Transportation to and from the NPH home/airport
- NPH USA interpreter and guide
- Travel insurance
- Background check

- \$400 deposit per individual/  
\$800 deposit per couple due by October 11, 2022
- Full payment and traveler forms due by October 24, 2022

### \*COVID-19 Protocols\*

In order to protect the unvaccinated and vulnerable populations in our care, visitors are required to follow all protocols set forth by the NPH home. These include **mandatory COVID-19 vaccinations\* and mask-wearing** and may also include (but are not limited to) a period of social distancing and a negative COVID-19 test.

*\*NPH El Salvador requires that all visitors have the full primary series of vaccinations against COVID-19 and also strongly recommends that visitors have all boosters for which they qualify.*

*\*If a visitor tests positive for COVID-19 during their visit and is unable to return home as scheduled, an NPH USA staff member will remain at the home with them to help coordinate their return.*

*\* Cost does **not** include air travel. **Do not book air travel** until further instructions are provided by NPH USA. \**
