Cost: \$1,320 per person | \$1,840 per couple

COVID-19 Protocols

In order to protect the unvaccinated and vulnerable populations in our care, visitors are required to follow all protocols set forth by the NPH home, which may include (but are not limited to) mask-wearing. All protocols are subject to change. See the FAQs on the trip website for more.

If an adult visitor tests positive for COVID-19 during their visit and is unable to return home as scheduled, an NPH USA staff member will remain at the home with them to help coordinate their return. If a minor visitor tests positive for COVID during their visit and is unable to return home as scheduled, an NPH USA staff member AND the minor's guardian or chaperone must stay with the minor at the home until a negative test can be produced.
