

OUR MISSION

NPH USA transforms the lives of vulnerable children in Latin America and the Caribbean by supporting the homes, health services and educational programs of Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH, Spanish for "Our Little Brothers and Sisters"). Together, we help children overcome poverty and become leaders in their own communities.

Founded in 1954, NPH is currently supporting more than 7,600 boys and girls in Bolivia, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua and Peru. In addition, our community outreach programs provided over 81,000 services in 2020.

WHAT MAKES US UNIOUE

- Our children are welcomed into a family for life and receive direct physical, emotional and spiritual support. This gives them security and a sense of belonging.
- Our children have daily chores, such as dusting or farming. This teaches them responsibility and they find pride in helping their family in this way.
- Our children are given a quality education and have the opportunity to pursue a trade or university degree.
- Our children give back a year or more of service to share the responsibility of raising the family.

OUR ORGANIZATION

We support NPH through fundraising and volunteer efforts. The organization is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors. In addition to our national office located in Illinois, we have six regional offices, each of which has its own volunteer Board of Directors. The members of our boards have diverse professional backgrounds and expertise, but each actively works to raise funds for and awareness of NPH USA and our mission.
