

## Highlights

- **Bolivia:** Opened two houses in Portachuelo for young adults transitioning from the NPH home to independent living
- **Dominican Republic:** Welcomed 56 at-risk children for temporary care at "Niños de Dios," (God's Children)
- **El Salvador:** Constructed two greenhouses and prepared the soil to grow organic food
- **Guatemala:** Opened a new Family Center to help children, people with disabilities, and single mothers
- **Haiti:** Renovated four houses at the main site and reinforced security measures at all facilities

*St. Damien Pediatric Hospital*: opened a Cholera Treatment Center in response to the major outbreak

- **Honduras:** Served about 300 vulnerable children and their families through the Family Center which provides physical and psychological therapy, training, and other services
- **Mexico:** Offered a youth educational program that provided resources on independent living, job skills/ job seeking, and public transport
- **Nicaragua:** Delivered 2,528 medical, counseling, and tutoring sessions to 63 families
- **Peru:** Inaugurated a sports field at the Family Community Center
