ABOUT NPH GUATEMALA

Opened in 1996, NPH Guatemala's Casa San Andrés is located 90 minutes west of Guatemala City. The 25-acre property has a Montessori preschool/ kindergarten, primary and middle schools, vocational workshops, and other facilities. The site is currently home to 60 children and supports 500 more through community programs.



An NPH USA representative will lead and oversee all travelers throughout the trip. All NPH USA representatives have been screened and are experienced trip leaders. A chaperone provided by the school will also be present to help the group.
