NPH USA transforms the lives of vulnerable children in Latin America and the Caribbean by supporting the homes, health services and educational programs of Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH, Spanish for “Our Little Brothers and Sisters”). Founded in 1954, NPH is currently supporting more than 7,000 boys and girls in Bolivia, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua and Peru.

Whether locally or internationally, the hands-on efforts of volunteers are the heart of our programs. They help children achieve their full potential, becoming productive, caring leaders in their communities and breaking the cycle of intergenerational poverty. Volunteers serve in roles of all kinds from fundraising to health care, office assistant to social worker.

National Office

Our national office in Chicago, IL, has the following ongoing volunteer needs for our Child Sponsorship Program:

- Translating correspondence: Spanish/English, French/English, and Haitian Creole. *Translators do not need to go to the office as long as they have Internet access.*
- General office assistance, including mailing letters, copying, filing, and special projects.
