ABOUT NPH EL SALVADOR

Opened in June 1999, NPH El Salvador's Casa Sagrada Familia (Holy Family), is located in Texistepeque near the border with Guatemala. The property includes a school, chapel, peace garden, dining room and kitchen, clinic, and houses for boys and girls, among other facilities.



An NPH USA employee and/or representative will lead and oversee all travelers throughout the trip.
