Founded in 1989 by Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH), meaning "Our Little Brothers and Sisters" in Spanish, **St. Damien Pediatric Hospital** (SDPH) was inspired by the vision of Fr. William Wasson and Fr. Rick Frechette, CP, D.O. Located in Tabarre, just outside Port-au-Prince, SDPH stands as a beacon of hope and healing. It is the only hospital in Haiti solely dedicated to pediatric, prenatal and high-risk maternity care, filling a critical gap in healthcare services.
